At the conference **the results and outcomes of the project** will be presented. The participants will, among other, have an opportunity to acquaint themselves with **decision-making tools for low carbon scenarios in transport and land use planning** developed in the project as well as with experiences of preparing **low carbon strategies and action plans in pilot municipalities and regions**. It will also be a place for exchange and for getting inspired about mobility and spatial planning solutions. An **excursion to Novo mesto** with sighting of the wider area as well as a visit to the historic town centre and presentation of mobility related projects in the municipality will round off the event.

The overall objective of the ASTUS project is to reduce in a long-term perspective the carbon impacts linked to daily trips in the Alps. The main aim is to assist local authorities with identifying and implementing long term solutions in both mobility and spatial planning, so that CO₂ emissions linked to daily trips in the Alps could be reduced. The partners work in pilot regions in Austria, Germany, France, Italy and Slovenia. The main project outputs include a transnational typology of Alpine territories, a CO₂ minimizer toolbox, local scenarios, strategies and action plans as well as transnational recommendations for reduction of CO₂ emissions in the Alps.

Venue

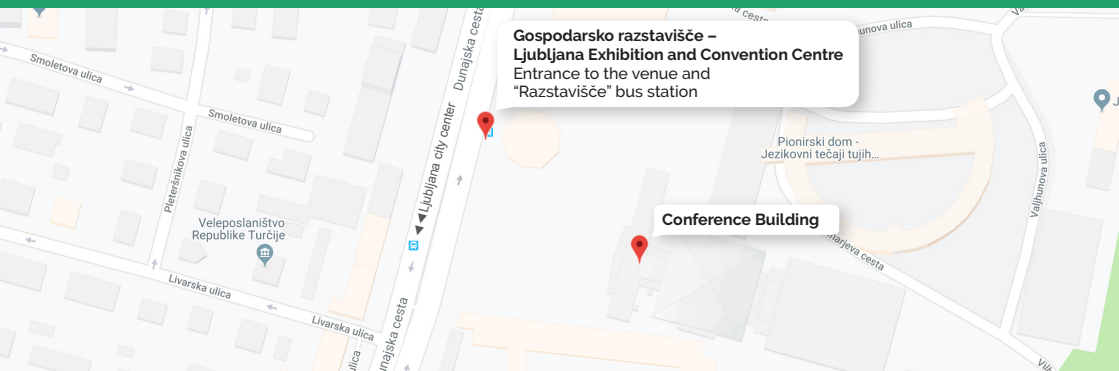
